

One tradition in the church during Lent is to fast – to "give up something for Lent." Typically, nowadays, fasting includes "giving up" something that will be challenging causing you to lean on God for help, pray to God more, and think about God more. Fasting (giving up something) is a fine way to focus your attention on Christ and the cross during Lent. But there are other ways to turn our focus to Christ in addition to fasting. In a devotion book by Rich Bimler, he calls these additional practices "Holy Habits." These "Holy Habits" are designed to become "Resurrection Routines" – practices that not only aid in your Lenten journey with Jesus to the cross, but also to turn your focus more intentionally and joyfully on the Resurrection message of the empty tomb.

These "Holy Habits" include: worship, prayer, laughter, Bible reading, listening to a friend, music, quiet times, play, confession, being salty, and more. Some of these "Holy Habits" might surprise you – but all are ways to turn your focus on God. There is a different "habit" for you to try each day of Lent. The Sunday before Ash Wednesday, the "Holy Habits" devotional book will be available as well as the devotional book that is the companion for our Wednesday worship, "Followers of the Cross" by Martin Marty.

Here is a Lenten challenge for you: spend at least ten more minutes a day (10 more minutes then you now spend) in intentional time with God each of the forty days of Lent (FYI - Sundays are not counted as part of the 40 days during Lent). You can try the Holy Habit listed each day in the devotional book or you can simply spend the time in prayer, Bible reading, or whatever places your focus completely on God for at least 10 minutes more per day than you do now. During this time, listen for God's spirit guiding you, giving you peace and healing your spirit.

May God richly bless your devotional time. May your faith grow richer and stronger. May you realize how deeply God loves you and cares for you.
